# POST STENT PLACEMENT PATIENT QUESTION

### WHAT IS A STENT AND WILL THE STENT IN MY BODY STAY THERE FOREVER?

A stent is a tiny wire mesh tube. t props open an artery and is left there permanently.

### DOES THE STENT EVER CLOSE UP AD NOT WORK ANYMORE?

It can happen. sometimes plaque or scar-like tissue builds up within the artery. However, to monitor the artery we will do an Ultrasound to look at it at 1 month, 6 months and one year.

## WILL I EXPERIENCE A LOT OF PAIN AFTER MY PROCEDURE?

Most patients have very little pain after this procedure. We recommend Tylenol for any discomfort you may have.

## WHEN CAN I GO BACK TO DRIVING?

The next day you can go back to driving and doing your normal activites.

#### WHEN DO I NEED TO FOLLOW UP WITH THE DOCTOR?

You can make an appointment for 2 weeks after your procedure. The doctor will go over the results of the procedure with you.

### WHAT CAN I DO TO HELP MYSELF?

- Quit smoking if you are a smoker.
- Be physically active walk, ride a bicycle, or do other types of moderate physical activity for 30 minutes a day.
- Lower your blood cholesterol levels by eating healthy foods (high in fiber and low in saturated fat, trans fat, and cholesterol).
- If you have diabetes, work with your doctor to keep your blood sugar under control.
